GMO-Declaration for Beer-Products


Dear Sir, dear Madam,

We hereby declare that the processing aids listed in annex are excluded from the scope of application of EU Regulations (EC) No. 1829/2003 and (EC) No. 1830/2003. The use of these products does therefore not require any labelling according to the mentioned regulations, irrespective of their GMO status.

Based on current declarations from our suppliers, we furthermore declare that products listed in annex (processing aids and additives), are not subject to the obligation of labelling according to Regulation (EC) No. 1829/2003 and Regulation (EC) No. 1830/2003, not even, if the processing aids are equated with food and assessed as such. The products mentioned are no GMOs, do not contain GMOs and are not made from GMOs. We have identical declarations from our upstream suppliers for the raw materials we use.

All products made from microorganisms using a fermentation process were analyzed with respect the organisms used not to constitute a GMO within the meaning of Directive 2001/18/EC. If conventional mutagenesis or cell fusion processes within the meaning of Annex I B of Directive 2001/18/EC are used, they can be considered safe as they have been established well before the mentioned directive was issued.
