

# Information on the change of labelling 2024

From 8 December 2023, all labels of wine products and aromatised wine products must include mandatory nutritional information and a list of ingredients. This regulation applies to all products produced after this date, including vintages from 2024 onwards. All ingredients and additives must be listed. To make it easier to design the labels correctly, here is an overview of the Erbslöh products to be labelled and possible alternatives.
